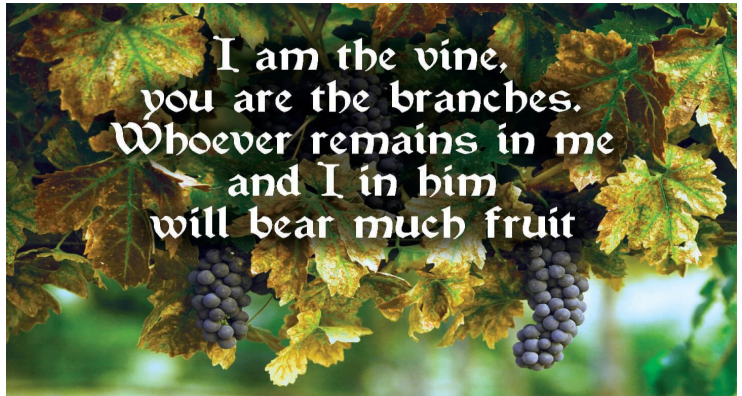


2018 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL
