

**PARISH FESTIVAL 2017**

The sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation complete the sacraments of initiation that began with Baptism. "By means of these sacraments of Christian initiation, [the faithful] thus receive in increasing measure the treasures of the divine life and advance toward the perfection of charity." (CCC 1212)
