CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR'S MASS SCHEDULE

Christmas Day this year is on Monday, which means that Sunday Dec. 24 is the Fourth Sunday of Advent. We must celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent in the morning, before anything can be done for Christmas. *Attending Christmas Eve Mass at 5:00 pm does not count as your Sunday Obligation!*

Masses for Christmas this year are at 5:00 pm on December 24, Midnight Mass, and 9:00 am on December 25 Christmas morning. *There will be no 8:00 pm Mass celebrated on Christmas Eve this year.*

January 1, the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year since it falls on a Monday. There will only be one Mass for this celebration, at 9am on Monday.
