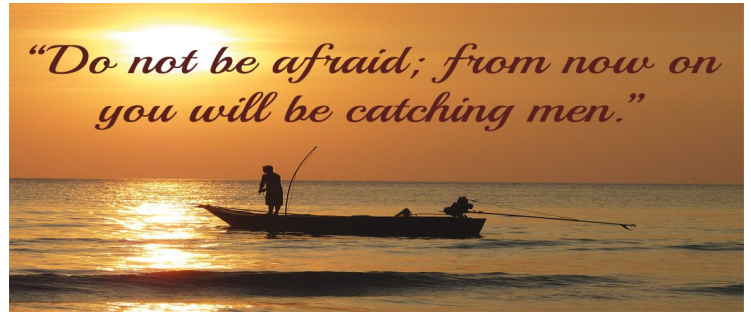

**WHAT DOES EDCHOICE MEAN FOR SACRED HEART SCHOOL?**

The EdChoice Scholarship Program provides up to 60,000 state-funded scholarships to students who attend low-performing public school buildings. The scholarship must be used to attend private schools that meet requirements for program participation. Coshocton City Schools and Ridgewood Elementary Schools have both been designated as low-performing by the Ohio State Department of Education. **SH YOUTH GROUP & SH SCHOOL'S SHOE DRIVE**

Clean drinking water is a very important resource that should be available to all people. In many small communities around the world, women have to travel many hours and miles just to obtain water. They carry buckets filled with water, which can be very heavy, all the way back to their community. Carrying this water for this long distance is not only hard due to its weight, but also because it is very easy for the water to spill out of the bucket. Since some water is lost, the trip to obtain water may have to be made multiple times per day.

After the difficult trip with the water, a lot of the water is not actually safe to use. According to research done by the WaterStep Organization, about 748,000,000 people across the world do not have access to safe water. This research also shows that 80% of all diseases around the world are caused by water that is contaminated and approximately 3,400,000 people die each year due to water related diseases. These are huge numbers caused just by water, which is a resource that most people in the United States take for granted.

So, how can you help? Through a organization called WaterStep. This is an organization that assesses water problems in communities that do not have safe drinking water. Then volunteers implement ways to obtain safe water and educate the local people on ways to more easily get the clean water to drink. This program enables communities to take care of their own needs when it comes to safe drinking water. In order to obtain the tools needed, the WaterStep Organization collects new and used shoes to fund the making of tools used to collect water and/or funds to create water wells in communities. Sacred Heart Youth Group along with Sacred Heart School will be hosting the shoe drive. There will be boxes placed in the church and in the school outside of the office. If you have any unneeded shoes, please bring them into our collection boxes. Our last drive collected 387 pounds of shoes and we would like to increase this amount.
