

WHO AM I TO JUDGE?**SESSION 2: RECOVERING THE BASICS: VIRTUE AND FRIENDSHIP**

In America, as we strive to learn as much as we can to be competent in as many areas of our complex lives as possible, the one area that may suffer because of our excessive busyness is **RELATIONSHIPS**. God created us to totally love Him, and to love others as ourselves; or simply to invest our lives in **RELATIONSHIPS**. C.S. Lewis compared the human family to a fleet of ships. An elementary goal of a fleet of ships is for the ships not to collide into each other. But for this to happen, **EACH** ship must be able to run properly to be steered in the first place. In our lives, for each individual "ship" to run properly, "virtues give us the grace and skills to live within the 'fleet' well." Dr. Sri provided several analogies of relationship virtue development. He explained even if a prospective driver knows all the rules of the road, it will not prevent her from crashing the car, if she does not first practice and develop driving skills. Likewise, we must develop virtues of becoming unselfish and courageous to help and not hurt others. In essence, social harmony is based upon internal harmony.

Our moral harmony can malfunction in different ways: 1) By our actions hurting other people, and 2) By failing to do positive actions that benefit others. Dr. Sri, using sport terminology, asserted that the team member needs to use all aspects of her skills required to play the sport effectively, otherwise she is letting down her team. On the job, if the worker spends time on personal Facebook rather than targeting job tasks, she is letting down her employer. If the college student slacks off in studying, he will only have access to the poorly learned skills needed for his job. In all aspects of our lives, we need to give our personal best. However, people may focus on making money and gathering material goods instead of spending quality time with others. How many children have been wounded by a Dad who did not have time for them as he was preoccupied by his career? We can rationalize the choices we make, but honest self-assessment helps us answer, "Who do I want to become?"

A truly great culture results from those who accomplish difficult things for others. What do we long for in our lives? We strive for sustaining love and unity in our family and society; not just because we value it; we need the skills or virtues developed over a period of time to maintain relationships. Dr. Sri clarifies this point by explaining we may value surgeons and pilots, but we may not have the skills to BE surgeons or pilots. In a similar vein, many jump into relationships without the necessary virtues to sustain them. How do we develop relationship virtues? Do good consistently enough that we do good easily, and with joy. How do we grow in virtue? 1) We **EDUCATE** ourselves through study of the lives of the saints. 2) We **PRACTICE** what they did in our daily life. 3) Through the sacraments, ask for forgiveness for our past hurtful behavior, and seek God's help in trying to be more virtuous. We cannot simply decide to be a great spouse and parent; we need to form and practice relationship virtues.
