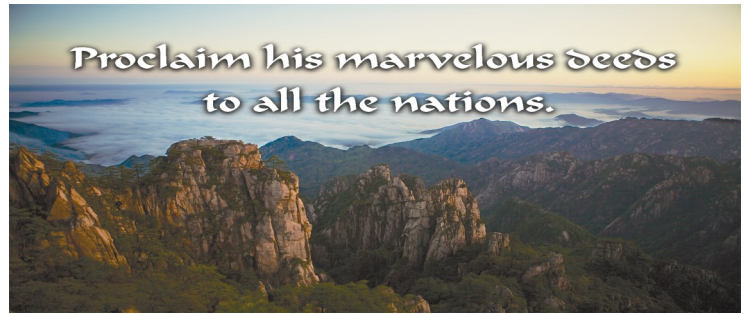


A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR:
