IN PRAYERFUL REMEMBRANCE

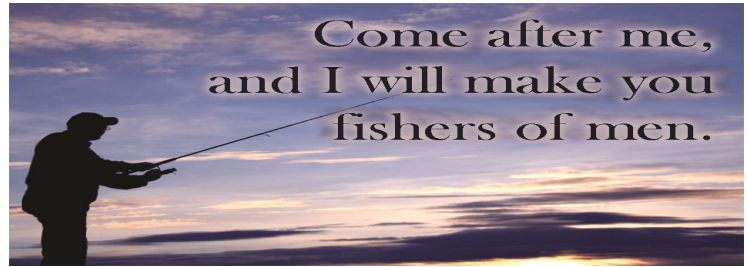
