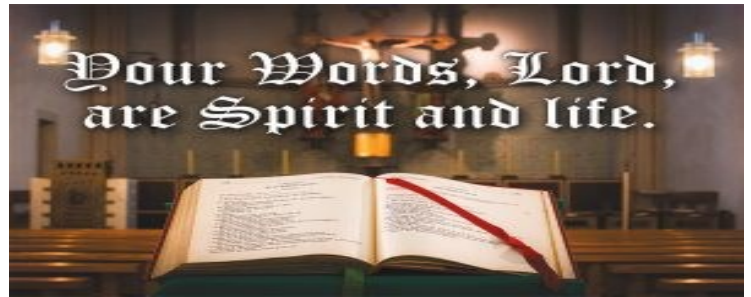
CONTRIBUTION YEAR-END STATEMENTS
