# PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE CENTENNIAL OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA APPARITIONS

In celebration of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, the Vatican has granted the following plenary indulgence:

- 1. To the faithful who visit the Shrine of Fatima in pilgrimage and participate in a celebration in honor of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.
- 2. To pious faithful who visit an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in any church, oratory, or adequate place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions (13<sup>th</sup> of each month from May to October 2017) and participate in a celebration in honor of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Creed, and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.
- 5. To the faithful who, due to their age, disease or other serious reason, are impeded from movement, if repentant of all their sins and having the firm intention of performing, as soon as possible, the three conditions mentioned below, in front of a small image of Our Lady of Fatima, spiritually unite in the days of the apparitions to the Jubilee celebrations, offering with trust to God all-merciful through Mary, their prayers and pains, or the sacrifices of their own lives.

To obtain the plenary indulgence, those truly penitent and animated with charity must fulfill the following three conditions: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

# OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese children received apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria, near Fatima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon. Mary asked the children to pray the rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners and for the conversion of Russia. The third visionary, Lucia dos Santos, became a Carmelite nun and died in 2005 at the age of 97.

Mary gave the children three secrets. Since Francisco died in 1919 and Jacinta the following year, Lucia revealed the first secret in 1927, concerning devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The second secret was a vision of hell.

Pope John Paul II directed the Holy See's Secretary of State to reveal the third secret in 2000; it spoke of a "bishop in white" who was shot by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows into him. Many people linked this to the assassination attempt against Saint John Paul II in St. Peter's Square on May 13, 1981.

The feast of Our Lady of Fatima was approved by the local bishop in 1930; it was added to the Church's worldwide calendar in 2002.
