

**PARISH FESTIVAL 2017**

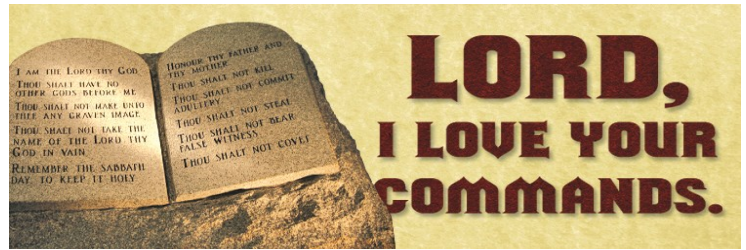
