

**PARISH FESTIVAL 2017**

This year our Parish Festival will be held on **Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup> from 5-9 PM**. Activities will be available throughout the evening to include children's games, popcorn, sno-cones, 50/50 drawings, silent auction and indoor bake sale. The evening will begin with the **Chicken Dinner from 5:00-7:00 PM** to include a half chicken, potato salad, baked beans, roll, drink and dessert for \$10.00 (provided by Baker's IGA Coshocton). There will also be hot dogs, chips, drink and cookie available for \$3.00. **Jim Brown/Booze Brothers** will provide entertainment throughout the evening.

In the weeks prior to the festival we will be selling raffle tickets after all Masses. We will announce when we begin the sales of tickets.

We will again have **Chicken Dinner** tickets available for sale beginning July 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. These will be passed out to parishioners after Masses as we did last year. **BI-MONTHLY HEALING MASS  
SAINT JOSEPH CATHEDRAL**

A Mass of Healing and Healing Service will be celebrated on Monday, July 17, 6:30 pm at Saint Joseph Cathedral, 212 East Broad Street, Columbus. Following the Mass, a Service of Healing will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Veneration of relic of the True Cross of Christ, followed by an opportunity for each person to speak individually with a priest and receive prayers of healing for what they seek; the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will also be available. The Service of Healing will close with Benediction. All persons who seek Christ's healing are invited – especially those who suffer with physical illness and infirmities (e.g. cancer and other debilitating diseases and conditions), in addition to those in seek emotional and spiritual healing. All caregivers, family members, and members of the medical community are invited as well. Parking is available at the rear of the Cathedral accessible off East Gay Street; handicap accessible elevator is located in the courtyard (west side of the Cathedral) on East Broad Street. Bi-monthly Healing Masses take place at the Cathedral on the third Monday of the month; during the remainder of 2017 they are scheduled for: September 18, and November 20.
