PLENARY INDULGENCE - OUR LADY OF FATIMA

In order to be properly disposed to receive the plenary indulgence granted by Pope Francis to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Mary at Fatima:

To pious faithful who visit an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in any church, oratory, or adequate place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions (13th of each month from May to October 2017) and participate in a celebration in honor of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Creed, and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. To obtain the plenary indulgence, those truly penitent and animated with charity must fulfill the following three conditions: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Fr. Victor will hear confessions on the following dates 1/2 hour before the daily Mass in the confessional: Thursday, October 12 and Friday, October 13.
