ST VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

The **Second Collection** next weekend October 28/29 will be for the St. Vincent de Paul Society of Sacred Heart Church. Our Fiscal Year, October 1, 2016 thru September 30, 2017 just ended. During that period, the Parish Office received 295 calls requesting assistance. We were able to help 394 individuals or families in some way. We dispersed \$11,597 for utilities alone (AEP, Columbia Gas, Frontier Power and Water), and \$7,430 was dispersed for rent assistance. A household may receive a maximum of \$150/year in assistance.

Most of the money that we receive comes from Fifth Sunday Collections. We have 5 in the 2017 calendar year. The people that we help are all going through difficult times in their lives. With your generous support, SVdP can continue helping those in need. **Thank you!!**
