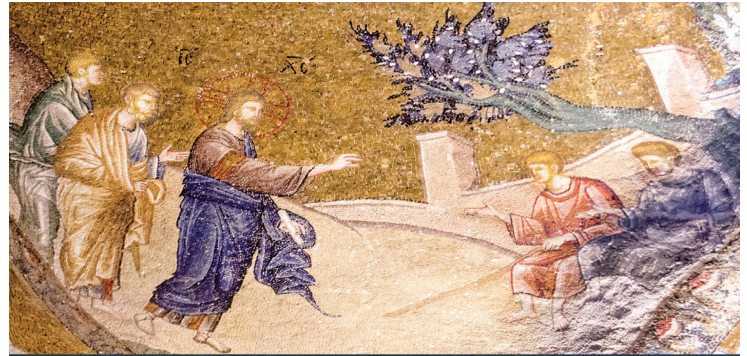


October is the Month of the Rosary, and as Catholics, we honor Mary, the Mother of God with this special devotion and with other prayers in her name.
