FALL BIBLE SERIES

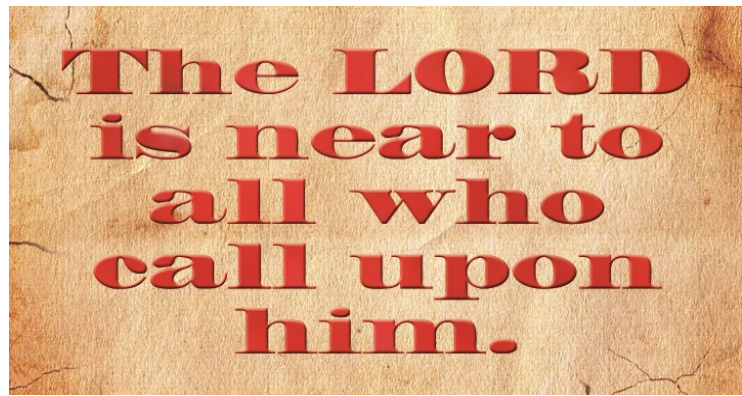
