**Festival Raffle & Quilt Raffle**

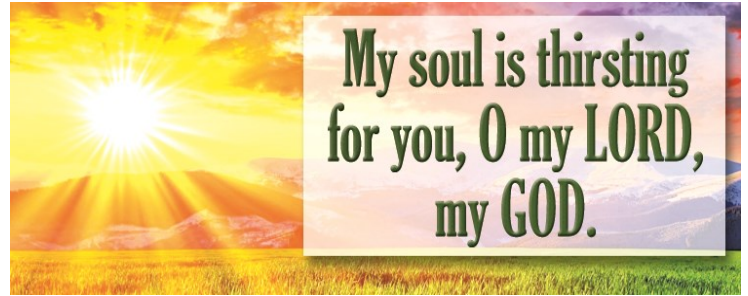
The Festival Committee will be selling Quilt & Festival Raffle Tickets after Mass this weekend.
