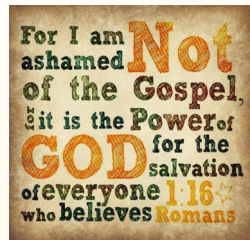

PREGNANCY DISTRESS CENTER 2ND COLLECTION

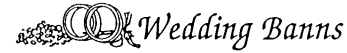
