Some of the purposes of Eucharistic Adoration are to draw us more deeply into the mystery of Christ's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist, to strengthen our relationship with Jesus Christ, and to express our love, gratitude, and respect for Christ our Lord.

WHAT DOES EDCHOICE MEAN FOR SACRED HEART SCHOOL?

The EdChoice Scholarship Program provides up to 60,000 state-funded scholarships to students who attend low-performing public school buildings. The scholarship must be used to attend private schools that meet requirements for program participation. Coshocton City Schools and Ridgewood Elementary Schools have both been designated as low-performing by the Ohio State Department of Education.
