**THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS**

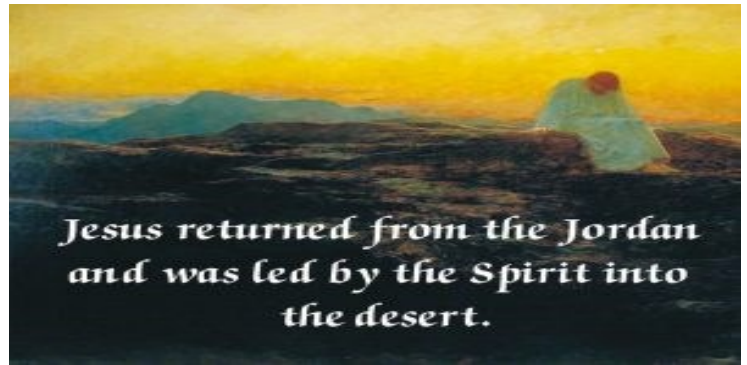
