*Friday, March 22 & April 12 from 5-7 pm*

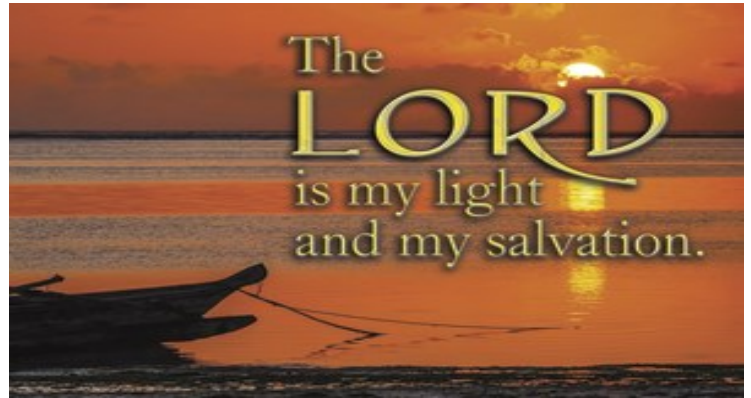
