

GENESIS TO JESUS

What is the Bible, where does it come from, and what is its purpose? How are Catholics supposed to read the Bible and what story does it tell?

These are the ever-important questions answered in *GENESIS TO JESUS*, the video Bible Study from the St. Paul Center. Join us to learn the basic Catholic principles for reading Scripture and to survey the broad outlines of the books of the Bible and their place in the story of salvation. *GENESIS TO JESUS* surveys the principal covenants that God made with his people through figures such as Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, and David. This study also shows how each of these covenants points forward to - and is fulfilled by - Jesus Christ and his Church. In this 12-part series, participants will see a panoramic vision of salvation history and humanity's place in this story.
