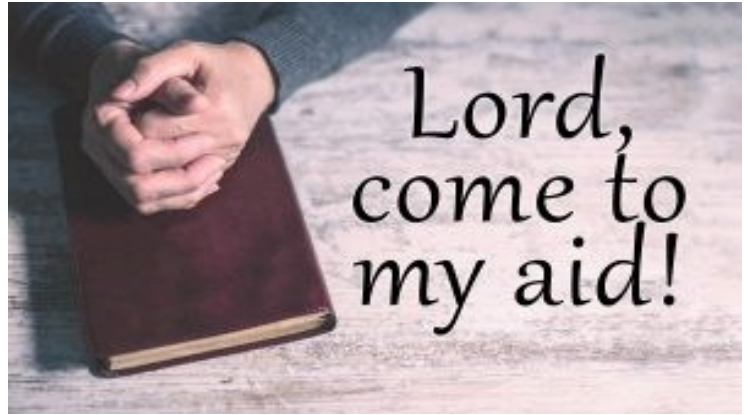
2019 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL
