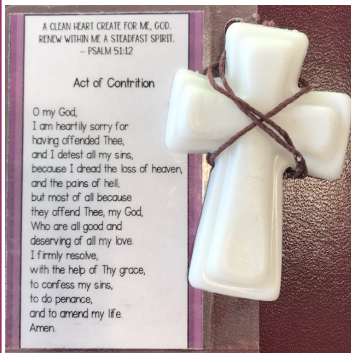

THE EUCHARIST - HEART OF THE CHURCH'S LIFE

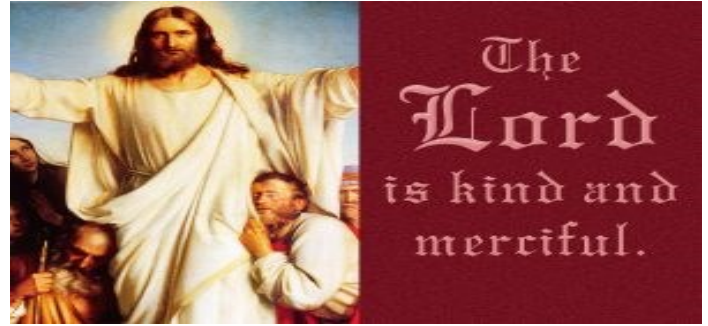

REFLECTION OF THE WEEK

How can I allow the Spirit to guide me more fully? How will that affect how I treat both those who treat me well and those who mistreat me?

In the Gospel this weekend, “You shall not bear hatred... take no revenge....love your neighbor,” God says to Moses. The difference is in how the word “neighbor” was understood. In Leviticus, “neighbor” meant “fellow citizen.” The Old Testament is filled with incidents in which the Chosen People took revenge against people and leaders who persecuted them, people who were not “fellow citizens.” What Jesus says, whether making a Samaritan the hero of the parable he used to answer the question, “Who is my neighbor?” or saying “Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,” is a radical change.
