~ BUILDING VIRTUE ~
FAITH

“Faith is the theological virtue by which we believe in God and believe all that He has said and revealed to us, and that Holy Church proposes for our belief, because He is truth itself.” By faith “man freely commits his entire self to God.”

For this reason, the believer seeks to know and do God’s will. “The righteous shall live by faith.” Living faith work[s] through charity.” (CCC 1814)

Faith is a verb, an active dialogue between God and Man, both a grace and a response to grace.

“Faith is a gift of God, a supernatural virtue infused by him.” (CCC 153)

So how do we grow in this virtue and walk in faith? We ask God what he wants in our lives, then we give ourselves over to his will.

BUILDING VIRTUE:

- Prayer:** Add a small prayer to your morning, starting in Lent, asking God to reveal his will to you and for an increase in the virtue of Faith.
- Sacraments:** The Sacraments are our “fuel for the journey,” infusing us with the grace we need to walk in faith. Commit to a weekly Mass, regular Confession, and Mass on one additional day per week.
- Giving Good Example:** We share our faith, not by words, but in the way we live. As we attempt to live a life of faith, we must do so with a joyful heart. You never know who is watching.

SACRED HEART SCHOOL REGISTRATION

Preschool Registration Packets can be picked up in the School Office. **Preschool (3 yrs old & 4 yrs old)** Those wishing to enter preschool must be 3 years old by September 30, 2020 and toilet trained. **Classes are 3 days a week on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday's from 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** Tuition is \$135.00 per month. We do not have grants available for this class. Please request an enrollment packet in the school office.

All Day Pre-K (4 yrs old) Mon-Fri (8:30-3:00) Tuition is \$335.00 per month or an income eligible grant is available. Please request an enrollment packet in the school office.

Kindergarten - Must be 5 yrs old by September 30, 2020 (only 3 spots open!)

Grant Deadlines for Tuition Assistance are March 15 for the Columbus Diocese Grants and April 10 for the Ed Choice Scholarship which allows students to enroll in Sacred Heart tuition free. Please pick up an enrollment packet in the school office or call at 740-622-3728.
