Question of the Week

*How can I keep a consistent forgiving attitude*

*that assuages my anger? What leads me to forgive one who hurt me?*

Anger is a basic human emotion, its welling up within us perfectly natural in many situations. However, if left to fester, or expressed as wrath or vengeance, it can become poisonous. Sirach tells us that "the sinner hugs (wrath and anger) tight" refusing to let go of their visceral reaction to being wronged (Sirach 27:30). Instead, we must embrace the golden rule, forgiving our neighbor so that we may be forgiven ourselves. Forgiveness opens the door for reconciliation.
