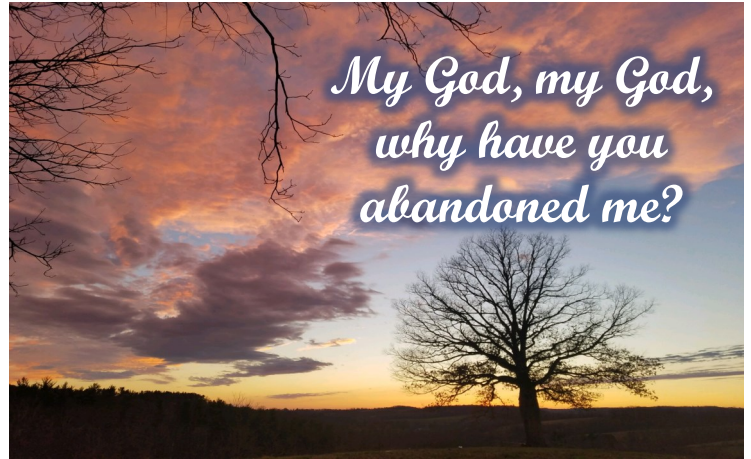


STATIONS OF THE CROSS

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE DAY...

Holding our blessed palms and shouting hosannas, today we commemorate Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. We do so with a note of melancholy, for we know that his arrival is also his entrance into the dark days of abandonment, agony, and death. However, we know that in the end God will triumph and sin, darkness, and even death will be defeated. Confident in Jesus' redemptive power we raise our voices in love and thanksgiving.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What cross do I find difficult to shoulder myself?

Whose burden have I been unwilling to share?

How can I help someone else and/or allow myself to be helped?

Today we hear the people of Jerusalem make two very different cries. As we commemorate the Lord's entrance into the city, we welcome their cheers of "Hosanna" showering praises upon their victorious king. But in the Passion, we hear their shouts of "Crucify him," calling for his death. The people have turned. The One exalted becomes the One condemned. The people failed to see the Messiah for what he truly was. Their Messiah would surely end Roman rule, free the people, and bring perfect peace. Most importantly, he would do all this promptly and painlessly. Those who shouted, "Crucify him" did not realize the necessity of his sacrifice, and so helped bring about his ultimate sacrifice.
