CROSIER FATHERS & BROTHERS**

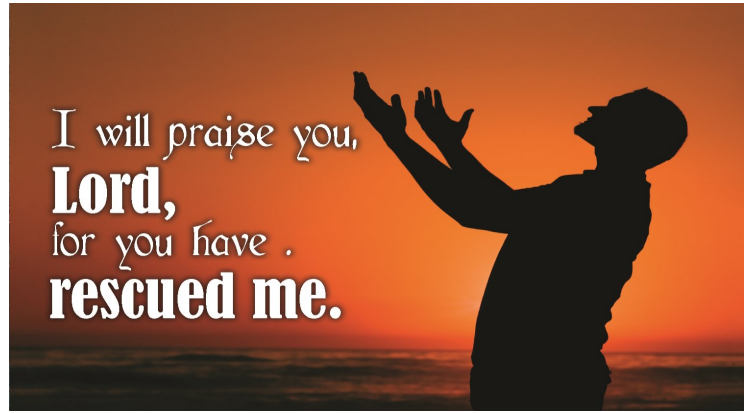
