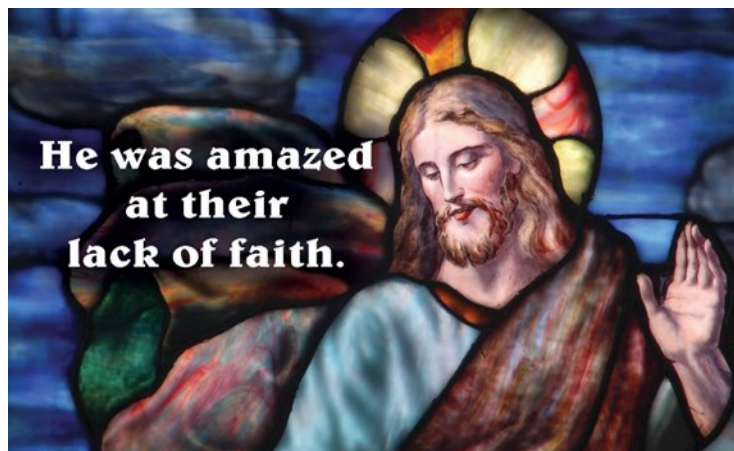


**WELCOME OUR NEW PASTOR!**

**QUESTION OF THE WEEK**

*How is Christ made manifest in me through my own weaknesses?*

It is a paradox of Christian life that in weakness we are made strong. Saint Paul recognized this phenomenon. He endured frequent hardships on his three lengthy missionary journeys, routinely traveling through hostile territory. He relied on the generosity of others for his basic needs, choosing to dedicate his life to preaching the gospel to the ends of the earth. He was arrested and imprisoned more than once, and constantly had to worry that he would not be able to continue his missionary activity. Those who knew him must have wondered how he could keep doing it. It must be the power of Christ. His faith, his reliance on the Lord, made the presence of Christ stronger within him, making Christ's power more apparent to others.
