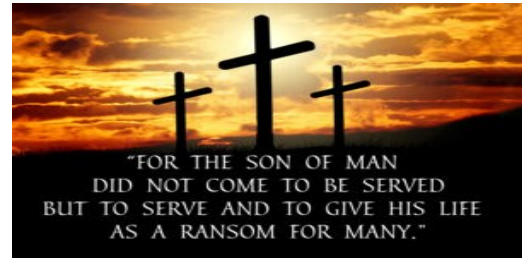
**BENNY'S BONE**
