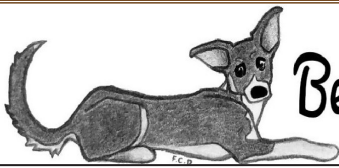


COLLAR CORNER

I came across this beautiful quote about the Rosary from Blessed Bartolo Longo: "Just as two friends, frequently in each other's company, tend to develop similar habits, so too, by holding familiar converse with Jesus and the Blessed Virgin, by meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary and by living the same life in Holy Communion, we can become, to the extent of our lowliness, similar to them and can learn from these supreme models a life of humility, poverty, hiddenness, patience and perfection." I love that Blessed Bartolo connects the Rosary with the Eucharist. 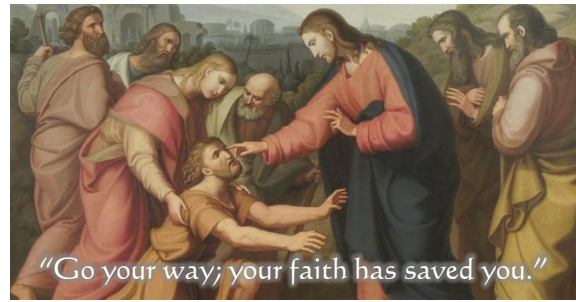
BENNY'S BONE ...CONTINUED FROM LAST WEEK
