As we come to the end of this month of the Rosary, I want to share a prayer I found from St. Louis De Montfort, a Saint who loved Mary and the Rosary. The prayer is meant to be prayed to begin the Rosary:

I unite with all the saints in heaven, with all the just on earth, and with all the faithful here present. I unite with you, my Jesus, in order to praise your holy Mother worthily and to praise you in her and through her. I renounce all distractions which may arise during this Rosary. I desire to say it with attention and devotion as if it were the last of my life. Amen.

There are many little gems in this prayer, but one that I wish to highlight is the renouncing of distractions. This really reveals the humility of St. Louis de Montfort. He recognized that distractions would come, so he specifically started each rosary renouncing those distractions. I imagine that after starting his rosary in this way, St. Louis was able to give each distraction to God as it came. Let's imitate this holy, humble saint by starting our rosaries and other prayers by renouncing distractions. St. Louis de Montfort, pray for us!
