Real Presence, Real Future Reflections

The young man in today's Gospel appears to approach Jesus with good intentions, yet also brings his brokenness, wounds, and pride. Jesus knew him and his heart, and he looked at Him *with love* while calling him deeper. Jesus does the same for us today, perfectly loving us wherever we are, yet inviting us into a deeper relationship with Him and asking us to cast aside anything that's in our way. This is impossible for us, but not for Him. Everything is possible with our Lord, whose Real Presence is always with us, looking at us lovingly and leading us into the Real Future to which He invites us.

Question of the Week

What am I willing to leave behind in order to follow Jesus more fully?

Even the disciples, who had indeed left their families, homes, and possessions behind to follow the Lord, couldn't fathom that anyone could possibly inherit eternal life. Jesus acknowledges that it is impossible for any of us to do it on our own. But it is not a matter of doing but in *being*: being a disciple. With God all things are possible. God is the doer. God offers to do it for us as well. We are called to be open to it, to be disciples. We pray that God's living word penetrate our hearts, opening them up to a transformation, readying us for God's saving grace.
