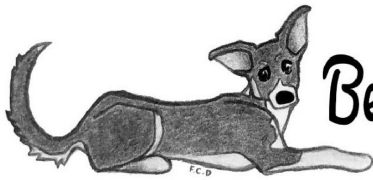


COLLAR CORNER

By his intercession, I pray that we all discover those unique talents God has given us so that we can put them at the service of God's Kingdom.
