Of what do I need to repent and how can my repentance produce good fruit?

The qualities of the Spirit of the Lord that Isaiah lists at the beginning of this passage may sound familiar, for they are the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which were bestowed on us all at Confirmation. The Holy Spirit enables us to continue the work of the Lord when we make the effort to use those gifts for the benefit of each other. In doing so, we produce good fruit (as John the Baptist call sus to do) and harmonize with one other (as Paul tells the Romans).
