How can I be a better witness to the truth, to what I see with eyes of faith?

Seven times in the first chapter of his Gospel John uses a form of the word testify to describe what John the Baptist has come to do. The word suggests a witness in a courtroom. Much later, when Jesus is called before Pilate to testify, he tells Pilate that he has come into the world "to testify to the truth". John's Gospel itself is his testimony of the Lamb of God, willingly led to slaughter to take away the sin of the world. To be a Christian is to be called to testify to the truth we know in the Lord.
